

GOOD THINGS TO BRING:

- Alarm clock/radio
- All-Weather clothing: Cleveland can be very warm in August/September and nippy in December/January/February and even March
- Backpack or bookbag
- Backrest or extra pillows
- Basket for shower items
- Bath towels
- Bathrobe
- Batteries
- Birth certificate (just a copy)
- Blankets
- Book shelf – you may wish to have a small shelf on which to keep materials organized
- Camera
- Can opener
- Car – if you wish you may bring one. Parking is somewhat expensive and if you bring a care also bring: “the club” as deterrent and
- Cards or board games
- Cell Phone (see also phones) AND Cell Phone charger
- Computer gear, including your operating system disks – ***You should bring a 15-20 foot Ethernet cable to ensure your desk can be placed where you want in the room and still reach the computer switch.***
- Cooking supplies if you choose. [pot and pan, can opener, baking tray....]
- Concert Dress black clothing
- Cork bulletin board or dry-erase board
- Cutting board
- Decorations – [posters, plants, other personal items to make if feel like home] please coordinate some of this with roommate.
- Desk lamp
- Dishes, silverware, cups, and storage containers (just a few)
- Drivers license and Social Security card, passport
- Drying rack for hand-washed laundry
- Duct tape- you never know!
- DVD player – if you wish
- Earplugs
- Emergency sewing kit
- Extra eyeglasses or contacts (or bring your prescription)
- Face cloths
- Fan
- First aid kit
- Flashlight
- Flip-flops or shower sandals
- Garbage bags (small)
- Glass cleaner and sponge
- Glue and/or superglue
- Hand towels
- Headphones
- Health insurance card – if being carried on your parents insurance
- Houseplants

Cutter 2010 – Residence Hall Necessities List

- Humidifier (In the winter months, with the heat on, the rooms can become very dry. This is especially recommended for vocalists.)
- Instrument
- Laundry bag or basket
- Laundry detergent and stain stick or spray
- Light bulbs (for any lamps *you* bring – **NOT HALLOGEN**)
- Lint brush or tape roller
- Masking tape and/or self-stick adhesive
- Music Stand – you are permitted and encouraged to practice in your room
- Paper Products: paper towels, napkins, facial tissue
- Pens, pencils, pencil sharpener, markers
- Phone – While most students will use their cell phones for calls, it is recommended that you or your roommate bring a regular phone to connect to the room jack.
- Photographs and mementos from home
- Pillow and pillow cases
- Plastic crates for extra storage (they work as filing cabinets, too)
- Plastic storage bin with lid (if you plan to keep any food supplies in your room) – this helps decrease chances of mice
- Power strip – perhaps with longer power cord (fire code does not allow regular extension cords)
- Quarters – for laundry and/or snack and soda machines
- Raincoat
- Rug if desired
- Screwdriver
- Sheets (**Extra Long Twin**)
- Sleeping bag (for guests)
- Small refrigerator – up to a 4 cubic foot size is permitted → please coordinate with your roommate
- Small wash tub or basin
- Stamps and envelopes – for those times when snail mail is better
- Static Guard
- Surge protector or power strip with extra long lead power cord
- “Swiffer” cloths or other dusting cloths
- Tape measure
- Television → another good item to coordinate with your roommate
- TV Cable – bring cable to connect to faceplate/cable tv source
- Towels
- USB portable drive – for easier transfer of documents between computers
- Umbrella
- Writer’s guide or grammar book
- Zip-top plastic bags

DO NOT BRING:

- Air Conditioners
- Alcohol
- Answering Machine – the voice mail system is free and has VoIP voice mail, many of you will use your cell phones.
- Candles
- Drug paraphernalia *or* drugs!
- Extension cords – extension cords are not permitted due to fire codes – bring surge protector/power strip with longer power cord
- Halogen Lamps

- Hot Pot, hot plates, toaster ovens, George Foreman grills, Sandwich makers or microwaves (a microwave is available on each floor). Due to fire code issues these and other cooking devices are not permitted in the rooms.
