



Graduate Student Additional Information Form For U.S. Citizens and Permanent Residents

This voluntary form is intended to provide applicants an opportunity to document any additional factors for financial need consideration that would not otherwise be known to CIM, as they are not part of the FAFSA data requests.

Please check all that apply and be sure to provide the required supporting documentation as noted below:

Private Student Loan Debt

This refers to any non-federal student loan taken out by you, the student. Please attach a statement of the account dated within the past 30 days with your name and current loan balance pre-printed. Car loans, credit cards or other debt is not applicable. All prior federal loans are included on the processed FAFSA results sent to schools. Loan Principal Balance \$

Do not include PLUS Loan debt related to sibling educational expenses. Please attach a statement of the account dated within the past 30 days. Loan Principal Balance \$

Other extenuating circumstances

Please attach a written statement including any other information you feel is relevant for the CIM Financial Aid Committee to consider. We ask you to submit this now, so if/when you are admitted, we already have this information to take into account when we deliberate your financial aid offer. Generally speaking, parental related issues are not relevant to the graduate student financial aid criteria and should not be included in this process, as by default, all graduate students are automatically classified as independent for federal aid purposes. No parental information goes into your financial need calculation on the FAFSA (even if it is entered, it's not part of the formula for your EFC). We prepare our financial aid awards for all graduate students assuming there is no parental support.
