Required of all international students to confirm enrollment

Please submit this form (with documentation for page two) only if you have been admitted to CIM and are confirming your Intent to Enroll. This is required of all international students in addition to the \$600 Tuition Deposit and Intent to Enroll that you complete with the CIM Admission Office. Until you have fully documented ability to pay for your first academic year of enrollment at CIM, we are unable to confirm you as a new student. This is due by 4/15/12 for graduate applicants and 5/1/12 for undergraduate applicants. Beyond those dates, we cannot guarantee admission, but if the 12-13 class is not yet full, we will confirm on a first come, first served basis.

The information on this form is needed for CIM to process your I-20 as needed to obtain your student visa. We assume all international applicants will be studying under the F-1 visa category. If that is not your intent, please contact the CIM International Student Advisor for clarification.

The Cost of Attendance (tuition, fees, room and board and personal expenses) at CIM for the 12-13 academic year is estimated at \$59,750, which includes both direct/billed and indirect/nonbilled costs. If admitted, If you have been offered a scholarship from CIM, that amount is subtracted from the total amount you must document. You will find the specific amount you must document on your NetPartner "messages" screen in the topic "I-20 Documentation of Funding Requirement."

You are required to document resources to cover 12-13 costs. You are also expected to have the ability to cover the cost of subsequent years of your enrollment at CIM. Financial aid is typically renewed at same level, assuming Satisfactory Academic Progress is maintained and your cumulative Grade Point Average is always at 3.0 or better.

If sources of support as indicated by you on this form later become unavailable, CIM will not replace such loss with its own funds. Further, CIM academic regulations do not permit a student's dropping below full-time enrollment in order to engage in employment due to economic hardship. Therefore, loss of support may make it necessary for the student to request a leave of absence or withdraw from his/her study if other private sources of funding cannot be obtained.
